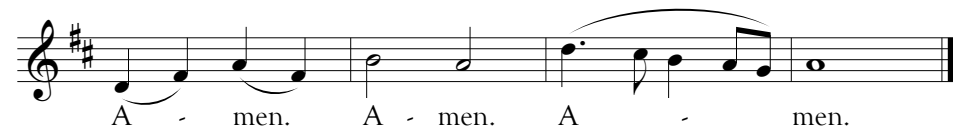

Agnus Dei [10³⁰] from Kleine Messe in F Doppelbauer

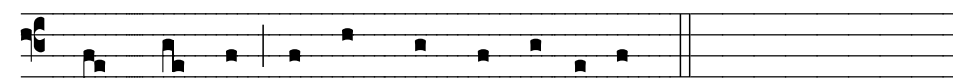
Communion Antiphon [Vigil, 8⁰⁰, 10³⁰] Dominus regit me Mode 2

Please respect our custom of standing in place and singing the entire recessional hymn.

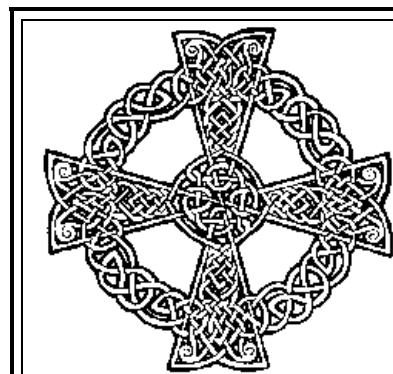

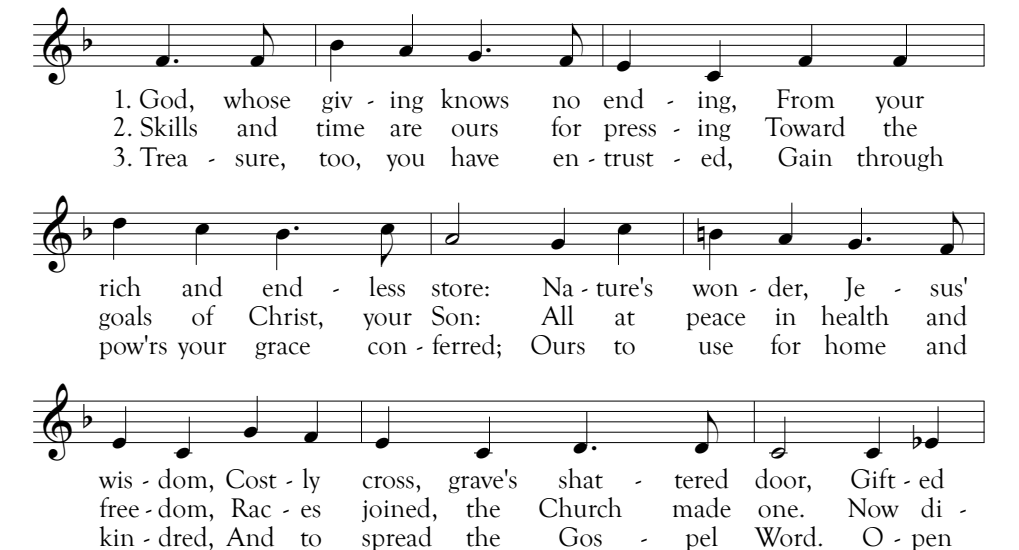
